

TIPS

Be early. Arrive at the gates when they open at 9 a.m. You'll get a jump on the crowd (which usually appears around 10 a.m.).

Making the most of the time you've got. Sources say that it takes 12-14 hours to fully appreciate each park's rides, attractions, themed eateries and boutiques. This means that you need (A) to buy a 2- or 3-Day ticket or (B) decide what you don't want to miss and budget your time accordingly.

Step away from the crowd!

Don't dawdle near the entrance... upon entering Universal Studios, head to the back of the park for the new **MEN IN BLACK™ Alien Attack™** (12 on map). Late in the afternoon is the best time for **TERMINATOR 2: 3-D BATTLE ACROSS TIME** (1) and **TWISTER... "Ride It Out"** (18).
